Acknowledgement of Colonel William Light

'The Council acknowledges the vision of Colonel William Light in determining the site for Adelaide and the design of the City with its six squares and surrounding belt of continuous Park Lands which is recognised on the National Heritage List as one of the greatest examples of Australia's planning heritage.'

- 4. Determines that any such additions to the final report constitute alterations of a minor nature only for the purposes of section 12(17) of the Act as the composition, ward boundaries and structure of the council in the submission remains unchanged.
