2 Conflict of Interest

- Sally Underdown declared a general conflict of interest in Item 6.2 [Park Lands Expressions of Interest (Multiple Sites)] pursuant to Section 74 of the *Local Government Act 1999* (SA) as she has an association with Pembroke School Inc but will stay in the room and participate in the discussion.

3 Presiding Member Report (verbal)

The Presiding Member provided a verbal report on various matters:

- After discussions in September 2025 by the Board to establish communications with the then Minister for Environment in relation to The World Heritage Bid the Lord Mayor received an acknowledgment of receipt although no appointment was offered. Subsequently, she has written to the new Minister for Environment to talk about our progress. The Lord Mayor has also written to the Attorney General and Premier in relation to Free, Prior and Informed Consent (FPIC) progress and our work with the Kaurna Yerta Aboriginal Corporation.
- The first of six statues of Aboriginal Elders was unveiled on 3 June 2026 of Lowitja O'Donoghue. All six will be established within the Park Lands and it is expected that they will be unveiled approximately once a year over the next five years.
- Two Council projects received awards at the 2026 SA Architecture Awards:
- Ashley Halliday was awarded the SA Architecture Medal, The Colorbond Award and The Derrick Kendrick Award for the collaborative work on Yitpi Yartapuultiku (The Soul of Port Adelaide) with Yitpi Yartapuultiku Aboriginal Working Group and Warren from Wax Design.
- The Heritage Architecture award was awarded to Swanbury Penglase for the refurbishment on the Adelaide Town Hall.
- Noting the Adelaide Aquatic Centre (Kauwinka) received awards for The City of Adelaide Prize for Design Excellence and The City of Adelaide Prize for Design Excellence People's Choice.
- The Lord Mayor has requested the Administration prepare a report on the establishment of committees to Kadaltilla to address particular opportunities and for this report to be brought back to the Board next month;
 - Population growth impacts on the Adelaide Park Lands, to include Inner Rim and Councils – on the basis of the growth of the City of Adelaide and its neighbouring Councils
 - Adelaide Park Lands Fund and APLMS Strategy investment Committee
 - Return Areas Committee – to look at areas that could be returned to Adelaide Park Lands
- The report will also consider membership and meeting frequency.
- The Board, can also set the purpose and the procedures to be observed in relation to the conduct of business of a committee
- It should be noted that the Presiding Member is required to be ex-officio to any Committee established and furthermore:
 - Kadaltilla Board Members can be included in the membership
- Committees are advisory to the Board and will not carry decision making powers, unless the Board decide to delegate that to a Committee.
