Purpose of the Committee

- 2.1 To make recommendations to Council on strategies, services, policies, and programs that assist Council to create a thriving city that is welcoming and accessible to all and that supports and celebrates its natural and cultural heritage.
- 2.2. This Committee will discuss matters, shape strategy, and make recommendations to Council to assist in the achievement of:
 - Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and cultures strongly represented in City life;
 - A healthy and resilient community
 - Community development and quality community services
 - Functional zero homelessness
 - A safe, affordable, accessible, well-connected city for all
 - Community use and access to the Adelaide Park Lands
 - Celebration of diverse community, culture and creativity
 - Beautiful surprising places

 - Protection, preservation, and promotion of our unique built, natural and cultural heritage.
