MOTION ON NOTICE

Councillor Janet Giles will move a motion and seek a seconder for the matter shown below to facilitate consideration by the Council:

'That Council requests administration undertake a feasibility study of making Sturt St. (between King William St. and Morphett Street) a 2 hour free parking zone prior to upgrading the parking metres on this section of Sturt St.'

ADMINISTRATION COMMENT

1. Should the proposed motion be supported by Council, a feasibility study to make Sturt Street (between King William Street and Morphett Street) a 2-hour free parking zone will be undertaken.
2. The timing and any potential changes will need to occur independently of the hardware replacement project noting:
 - 2.1. The replacement of all parking meters must be completed by 30 June 2024 due to the closure of the 3G mobile phone network in June 2024, making the current meters across the city obsolete.
 - 2.2. The replacement of parking meters in this area has already been procured, received, contracted and scheduled, as well as preliminary works undertaken to enable replacement machines to be installed in Sturt Street.
3. The study would consider the following: previous reports and trials, impacts to parking in Sturt Street and surrounding streets, revenue impacts, matters pertaining to parking legislation and community engagement.
