EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The *City of Adelaide Act 1998* requires the Capital City Committee (the CCC) prepare an Annual Report each year on the operations of the Committee for the financial year ending the preceding 30 June. Once prepared, the Annual Report (Attachment A) is required to be tabled in State Parliament and presented to the Council to note.

The Annual Report was tabled in State Parliament on 6 February 2024.

The Capital City Committee (the CCC) was established through the *City of Adelaide Act 1998* (the CoA Act), in recognition of the special role played by the capital city in South Australia's social, commercial, cultural and civic life. The CCC is the preeminent forum for the political partnership between the Government of South Australia and the City of Adelaide.
 2. The CoA Act requires the CCC Annual Report to be prepared each year on the operation of the CCC for the financial year ending the preceding 30 June, which is tabled in the State Parliament and presented to the Council to note.
 3. The CCC Annual Report 2022-23 has been prepared by the CCC Secretariat based in the Department of the Premier and Cabinet, in consultation with CCC Members and the CCC Executive.
 4. The CCC Annual Report 2022-23 was tabled in Parliament on 6 February 2024.
