Purpose of Presentation

This presentation by Michael Harvey, Director of the Botanic Gardens and State Herbarium of South Australia, will provide an overview of the Board's key strategic and master planning priorities, as well as upcoming initiatives.

The Kadaltilla / Adelaide Park Lands Authority (Kadaltilla) is the principal advisor to both the State Government and the City of Adelaide on the protection, management, enhancement, and promotion of the Adelaide Park Lands. Under section 9(c) of the Adelaide Park Lands Act 2005 (SA) (Link 1), Kadaltilla is required to:

"provide comments and advice on any management plan prepared by the Adelaide City Council or a State authority under this Act or the Local Government Act 1999 that relates to any part of the Adelaide Park Lands, and to monitor and, as appropriate, to provide comments, advice or reports in relation to, the implementation or operation of any such plan"

The implementation of the Adelaide Botanic Garden Master Plan and Botanic Park Master Plan is identified as an 'in progress' Strategic Priority in the Adelaide Park Lands Management Strategy – Towards 2036 (APLMS) (<u>Link</u> 2).

These plans are highlighted as Strategic Priorities for the Botanic Estate Lands and Adelaide Zoo Precinct.
