'That Council:

Requests the Administration to provide a report to the June scheduled meeting of Council on the number of buildings within the Council's boundaries identified by the City of Adelaide and by the State Government as requiring the replacement of combustible cladding, together with the timetable for the replacement of such cladding and:

- 1. An estimate of the cost of waiving all City Council planning fees to encourage replacement of combustible cladding and,
- 2. The possibility of either Council or the State Government or both establishing a concessional loans scheme to help owner corporations to remove combustible cladding.'

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## ADMINISTRATION COMMENT

- 1. If this Motion is supported, it should be noted that the work required to address points 1 and 2 of the motion may need to exceed the proposed June 2022 timeline.
- 2. We will coordinate with the State Government to ascertain to the best of our knowledge buildings in scope.
- 3. It is worth noting that any calculation of fees would be approximate as there are different ways in which effective cladding rectification can occur removal is not always required and different approaches attract different costs/fees.
- 4. Any estimate of the cost impact of fee waivers will then most likely be represented as a range.
- 5. We will provide an outline of approaches and the requirements for establishing the types of concessional loan schemes to address this issue.
