# PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

There are a range of opportunities for the City of Adelaide to work closely with nearby Council's, this includes the several "inner-rim" Councils of Burnside, Charles Sturt, Norwood, Payneham and St. Peters, Prospect, Unley, Walkerville, and West Torrens, as well as the City of Port Adelaide Enfield. How we work, partner, collaborate, share information, advocate and lead with these Council's will require further investigations, identified roles, detailed resources and where appropriate, adoption by Council. Opportunities will continue to be developed and resources identified, through the City of Adelaide's Service Delivery Planning and as articulated in the CEO Scorecard.



#### **ADVOCACY**

Enhanced relationship management through Lord Mayor and CEO partnerships, leadership and participation in local networks.



# **ARTS & CULTURE**

Share resourcing and knowledge to facilitate events, event strategies and live music with metro and regional councils.



# **CORPORATE**

Opportunity to share IT resources, access to Cloud based technology and support finance and rates related activities, such as valuations.



# **ENVIRONMENT**

Explore opportunities for carbon offset generation in regional councils, partnering with metro councils as potential purchasers.



# **HOMELESSNESS**

Advocating for funding and housing and homelessness reform at all levels of government through a local government network.



# **PARK LANDS**

Working together to enhance access to and from the Park Lands, shared recreation and maintenance, advocacy for funding models, review of Park Lands strategy, and options for governance of the River Torrens.



# REGULATORY

Shared legislative responsibilities provide opportunities to consider delivering shared services – for instance health, parking management, planning etc.



# STREETS & PARKS

Expand the provision of greenwaste and mulch. Work together to consider co-location of public realm activities and/or shared resources, and coordinate stormwater management plans.



# **WASTE & RECYCLING**

Collaborate to facilitate stronger policy and support for resource recovery in multi-unit dwellings from design through to occupancy.
