- 3. Casting of the vote by Council must be conducted as follows:
 - 3.1. Council must by resolution determine which candidates (being not more than two) they wish to elect.
 - 3.2. The Lord Mayor (or the person chairing the Council meeting) shall mark the ballot paper in their own handwriting with an "x" next to the candidate/s that Council wishes to be elected.
 - 3.3. The marked ballot paper must then be inserted into the small white envelope labelled 'Confidential Ballot Paper'. The sealed envelope must then be placed in the middle-sized envelope addressed to the Returning Officer. Council's name must be recorded on the envelope along with the signature of the Lord Mayor (or person chairing the Council meeting). The second envelope must then be placed in the large A4 envelope and delivered to the Chief Executive Officer of the LGFA.
- 4. The completed ballot paper must be delivered to the LGFA by 5:00pm on Friday 14 October 2022.
